(In addition to our \$5,000 donation towards the mortgage we also donate \$2,000 to the Pavion.) However , I feel our most important project is the one that I'm most pleased with: we've revitalized the youth group with the help[of our devoted Sunday School Teachers : Claudia Epure , Linda Kolton and Mary Olteanu, Alexandra Dima has also volunteered her services . We began with an afternoon of bowling at Nutmeg lanes with over 20 kids.

Please encourage them to continue. Our Thursday adult Bible Classes have slowly increased and the Seniors group has remained steady.

Our Parish membership has continued to grow since the schism and in spite of all the reposed members and we're still receiving requests for Membership applications.

Our 100th Anniversary at The Marriott Hotel was a very successful affair as well as the Retirement Dinner for us sponsored by the Parish Council. The Special Fund established in my name is at approximately \$20,000.
